- b) A part-filled IUCLID dataset in .i6z format to facilitate the Applicant’s registration dossier preparation
- c) A copy of the core data and the Chemical Safety Report, where applicable, submitted by the Lead Registrant including a full list of identified uses for the Substance according to what is known by the Consortium and any associated exposure scenario and the agreed classification and labelling (both as defined by the REACH Regulation).

The right to cite, use or refer to the Dossier is subject to the following restrictions:

- 1 The Applicant is allowed to refer to the Dossier for the sole purpose of registration under the REACH Regulation for **[substance name]**.

- 2 The right of referral is solely granted in favour of the Applicant and is neither transferable, nor assignable to any other entity even if it is the Applicant's affiliated company) or person, without prior written consent of the Consortium members.
- 3 In any case the Applicant shall not disclose to any third party any information (including without limit contents of the Dossier) and/or proprietary information received from the Consortium ("Confidential Information") without the prior written consent of the Consortium provided that the Applicant may disclose such information but only if required pursuant to the REACH Regulation by the European Chemicals Agency or other competent authority.
- 4 To the extent permitted by law, the Consortium shall not be liable to the Applicant for any direct, indirect or consequential loss or damage including loss of profit or of business, sustained by the Applicant.
- 5 This Letter of Access shall be governed by the Laws of England and Wales and the parties agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of England and Wales.
- 6 The Applicant shall not acquire any proprietary rights to any of the Confidential Information of whatever nature.
- 7 Nothing in this Letter of Access shall require any additional information or updates to the Dossier to be prepared by or for the Consortium and the Consortium may levy an additional fee to the Applicant for such additional information or updates prior to agreeing to make such disclosure.
